Patty Berg – most all rounded female junior golfer.

Nolan Henke – most all rounded male junior golfer.

**Steven Hutnik** (former Lee County School District administrator and former scholarship director of SWFJGA) – junior golfer with the longest longevity in the SWFJGA program.

**Ron Leatherwood** (longtime director of golf and PGA professional at Cypress Lake Country Club) – junior golfer who is pursuing a career in the golf industry.

**Robin Albright** (former president of SWFJGA and PGA professional) – junior golfer who is playing collegiate golf or entering into a golf profession.
